

SOCIAL COMMITTEE REPORT
March 12, 2016

The Social Committee meets throughout the year to decide on events for the Discovery Harbour Community. We provide a budget for most events and try to coordinate events that promote fun, social activities around the yearly holidays and provide great food along with entertainment and service activities (like the Labor Day Clean Up and BBQ).

Last year our budget was \$3,000.00. Some of our events are free, others are potluck w/coffee, water and soda provided. Our work events like the Labor Day Cleanup... lunch was provided. Our larger events like Thanksgiving Dinner and Holiday Dinner we charge for and ask for a can or cash food donation for our local food bank. These events have been well attended. We end 2015 w/\$ 675.00 .

Our events have been so popular that we can now see the need for a roof over the patio area - so that we can have additional seating outside for the Nov and Dec events.

Our committee also sees the need to have some low key Saturday 4 to 6 pm events just to gather and socialize... we decided to put these events under a "Fiesta" heading Spring, Summer, Fall "Fiesta".... these would be very in expensive with the community providing only coffee, water, soda napkins and paper plates and neighbors and friends bring pupus and their favorite drink... These "gatherings" will give neighbors a chance to get to know each other along with Board members and perhaps some local entertainment from time to time.

The first Fiesta will be April 2nd (4 to 6 pm) - an email was sent out and tickets are available at the office.

We will be asking for a similar budget for this years activities and invite everyone to participate in the events and in the planning process!!
